

Curriculum Statement

Our aim is to offer students a broad a balanced curriculum that takes into account the needs and aspirations of all our students. In KS3 (years 7 and 8) students study the following subjects:

English, Maths, Science, French OR Spanish, Technology (Food Technology, Textiles, Graphics, Resistant Materials), History, Geography, RE, ICT, PE, Art, Music, Dance and Drama.

In KS4 (years 9-11) all students study GCSE English Language, English Literature, Maths and Science. They can then select from a wide range of subjects at GCSE and/or Level 2 BTEC including History, Geography, RE, Business Studies, PE, Art, Music, Performing Arts, Media Studies, Textiles, Food Technology, Graphics, Resistant Materials, IT, Computer Science etc .

In KS5 (years 12 and 13) students study a maximum of four Level 3 courses (A levels and/or BTEC Level 3). There is also the opportunity for students to re-take GCSE Maths or English.
